Services take place in a secure and non-secure setting. This therapist is responsible to ensure coordination of service delivery including providing individual, group and family counseling, conducting programming, making referrals to community services, crisis intervention, suicide evaluations, etc. This therapist will also serve as the treatment provider for our specialty drug court programs. The therapist participates in treatment and staff meetings, policy and procedure creation and assists in program development. You may be expected to speak in front of groups, testify in court, advocate for the clients and liaison with community professionals.
